

2024 Outcome Summary

United Rehabilitation Services of Greater Dayton

Youth Services Outcomes

- 59% of children mastered key skills in the Get Set for School program.
- 37% of children receiving personal care supports increased independence.
- 100% of families agreed services enhanced their child's quality of life (+27% from 2023).
- Served 164 children in 2024 (26.2% increase from 2023).

Adult Day Services Outcomes

- Served 114 adults in 2024 (7.5% increase from 2023).
- 90% participated in community outings at least twice per month; over 500 outings total.
- 9 DSP's completed DODD training; 68% staff retention rate (10% above state avg).
- Volunteered 698 hours with local partners like Miami Valley Meals and Boonshoft Museum.

Employment Services Outcomes

- 233 individuals served in 2024 (38.7% increase from 2023).
- 62 individuals obtained competitive employment (60% placement rate).
- 65% achieved employment in under 180 days; 87% within 270 days.
- 100% of Project SEARCH graduates placed in jobs.
- 91% completion rate for Summer Youth Work Experience.
- Average satisfaction score: 4.8/5.0.

Therapy Services Snapshot

- 613 individuals served in 2024 (17% increase from 2023).
- 219 received Speech Therapy, 204 Physical Therapy, and 190 Occupational Therapy.
- Common diagnoses: Speech Delay, Autism, Developmental Delays, Cerebral Palsy.

Total Individuals Served in 2024

- URS served a total of 1,124 individuals across all programs - a 21.1% increase from 2023.
- This includes Youth Services, Adult Services, Employment Services and Therapy Services.
